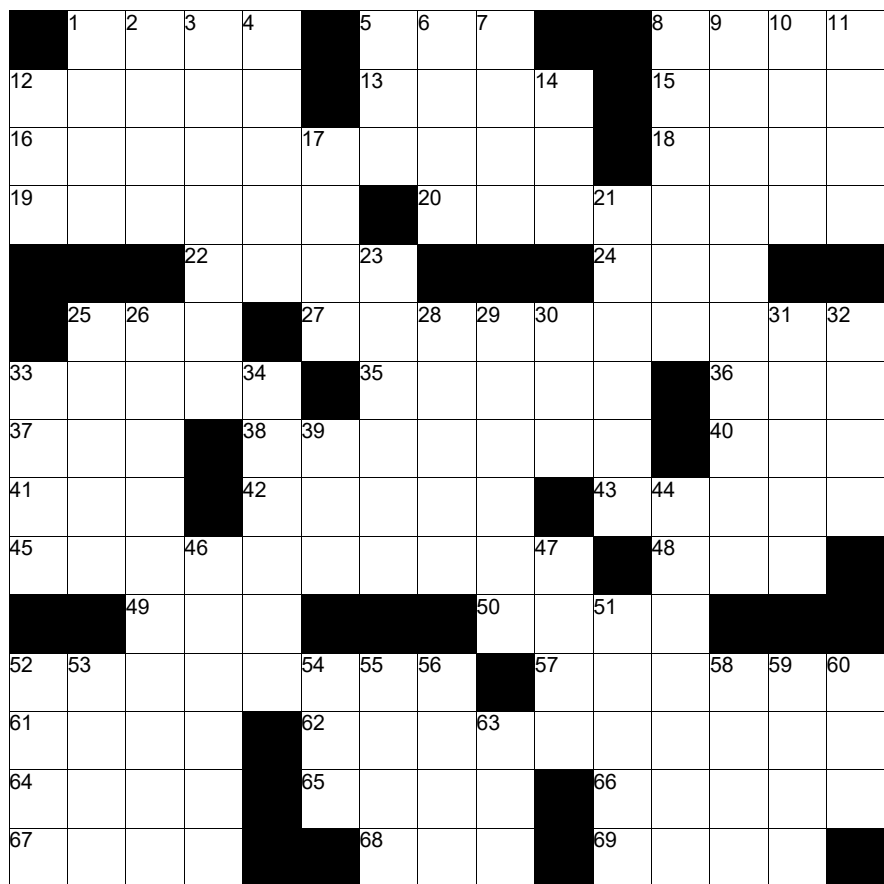


"Do Like I Do" a metapuzzle by Peter Washington with clues by Kate Washington
